RENTERS RELIEF **APRIL 1- OCTOBER 1, 2013**

The State of Connecticut provides a reimbursement program for Connecticut renters who are elderly or totally disabled, and whose incomes do not exceed certain limits. Persons renting an apartment or room, living in cooperative housing and individuals residing in mobile homes who pay monthly lot rent may also apply. The rebate amount is based on a graduated income scale; and the amount of rent and utility payments (excluding telephone) made in the calendar year prior to the year the renter applies - (2012 info).

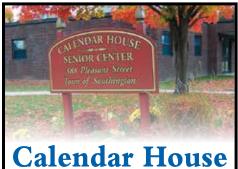

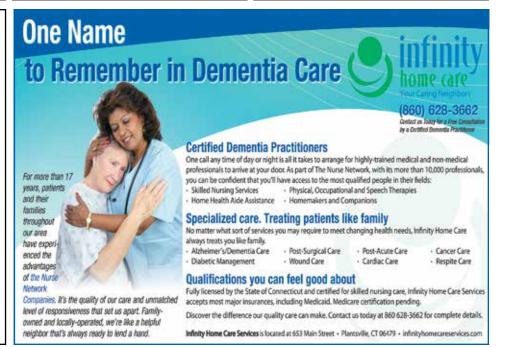
